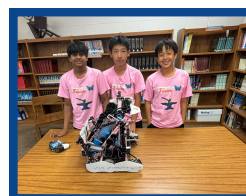
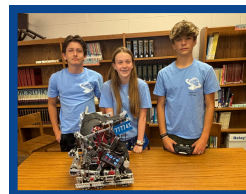
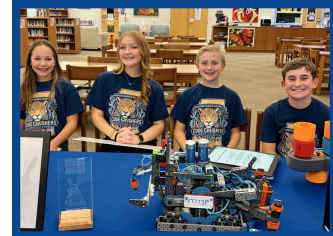
## 7TH-GRADE BETA CLUB PARTICIPATES IN DAY OF SERVICE

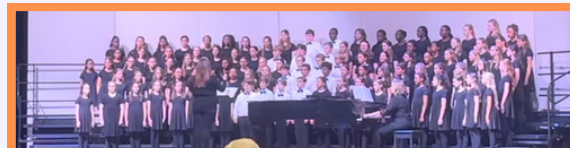

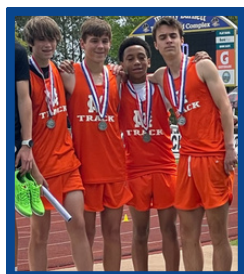
## MMS TRACK RACES TO A STRONG FINISH

We wish Mr. Adams the very best as he continues to lead with purpose, inspire those around him, and make a meaningful difference each day. Madison Middle School is lucky to have him!

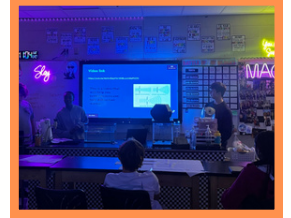
## MMS HONORS PARAPROFESSIONALS

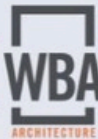
