**6th grade at 6pm. 7 & 8 grades at 7:30pm. No admission.**

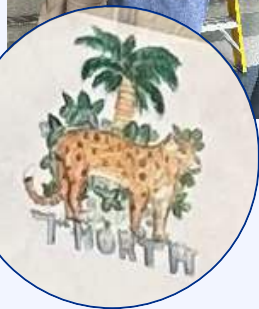


### 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Choirs

1st Place

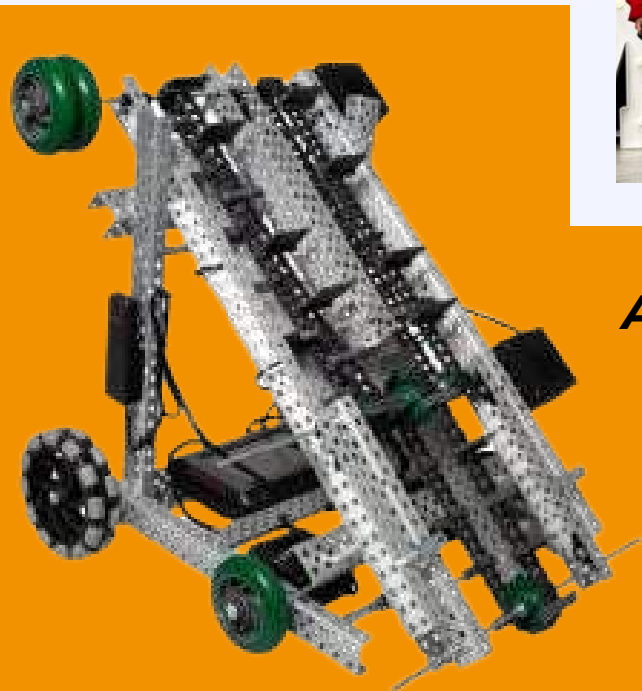
Liam Richardson, Daniel Wu, Austin Yang, and Daiwik Malhotra won 1st place in the state!
